 - o Ephesians 4:11-16 NRSV
 - APEST Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Shepherds (Pastors), Teachers
 - Not titles, but gifts God has bestowed on people
 - The best teams have at least one person with their primary gift(s) in each area
 - We are called to engage in each of these areas
 - Hebrews 5:12-14 CEB
 - Those with strengths in each are called to train others for that area of ministry
 - o Acts 1:8 NET
 - The Holy Spirit empowers us to witness & gives us gifts to do so
 - o 1 Corinthians 12:27-31; 13:1-3; 14:1-5, 39-40 NIV
 - Each of us is part of Christ's body
 - Gifts given by the Spirit for the benefit of all
 - Desire the greater gifts
 - We can ask the Spirit for more gifts, but God will not always grant them
 - None of these gifts mean anything if we don't have Love!
 - o Romans 12:3-8 CEB
 - Humility think of yourself the way God thinks of you
 - We are one body and belong to each other
 - Each of us are given different gifts
 - APEST, considered primary gifts, with other gifts being tools in your toolbox
 - o 1 Peter 4:10-11 CEB
 - Use your gifts to serve others for God's glory
 - John 13:14-15 CEB
 - Jesus acted as a servant
 - We must serve in any area God calls us to, regardless of our giftings

Apostle

- o Gifted to be a Messenger, Ambassador, Sent one
 - Entrepreneurial, Pioneers Gifted in church planting or starting ministries
 - Raise up and develop others; Send others
 - Drawn to design, systems and overarching organizational structures
 - Understands the goals/vision God has for a ministry/church to keep it on course
- May struggle with being overly goal oriented, driven, demanding, bossy, insensitive,
 unable to follow others, and a lack of gentleness and patience when being misunderstood
- Suggested Ministries: Church Planting, College, Cross-Cultural, Administration

Prophet

- o Gift to be able to hear and speak Spirit-inspired messages
 - Declares God's will for exhortation, correction, prediction, comfort, or inspiration
 - Requires humility and allowing others to push back
 - Requires continual prayer and study of the Word to test before speaking
 - Messages discerned by the Spirit, Word, and Community (local, global, historic)
- May struggle with being judgmental, critical, strong-willed, unforgiving, blunt, unencouraging, stubborn, argumentative, arrogant, self-righteous, bitter
- Suggested Ministries: Discipleship, Counseling, Worship, Creative

Evangelist

- o Gift to share the Gospel with unbelievers
 - Has a burden for the lost and is able to overcome the normal fear of rejection
 - Strong communicators that share their thoughts and feelings in convincing ways
 - Enjoys meeting new people, recruiting and gathering them together
- May struggle with listening, over-talking, interrupting, unsolicited advice, unwise choices, exaggerating/lying, over-sharing, needing approval, discouragement, dropping friendships
- o Suggested Ministries: Outreach, College, Missions, Welcoming, Kids, Preaching

• Shepherd (Pastor)

- Gift to assume responsibility for the spiritual welfare of a group of believers
 - A pastor, an undershepherd since Jesus is the only true Shepherd
 - Provides personal and emotional support
 - Can quickly discern when someone is not doing well
 - Loyal, often good listeners, and good at being there for someone in need
- May struggle with being easily hurt, overwhelmed, emotional, indecisive, dependence on appreciation, fear of offending/disappointing, overextended, lack of boundaries, slow to act
- o Suggested Ministries: Care, Marriage, Counseling, Kids, Worship, Creative, Hospitality

Teacher

- o Gift to communicate the truths of God's Word so that others can learn
 - Enjoys research, learning, and sharing what they've learned
 - Helps others to understand complex truths and formulates pathways of learning
 - Protects the church from abusing or taking Scripture out of context
- May struggle with being a know-it-all, legalism, valuing information over people, bluntness, lack of empathy, not listening, not serving with their hands
- o Suggested Ministries: Preaching, Teaching, College, Discipleship, Writing, Tech
